### KEN'S HOUSE

#### EMERGENCY RESIDENCE FOR PERSONS MADE HOMELESS BY A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RESTRAINING ORDER OR NEEDING SHELTER FOR A COOLING OFF PERIOD TO AVOID FURTHER LEGAL ENTANGLEMENT

If you have been removed from your home by a civil Protective Order, you are eligible for transitional living services through the New Mexico Divorce Education Project, a service of coyote-tecolote-cuervo.org, a 501c3 public charity. The invitation also extends to anyone needing a cooling off period to stave off further deterioration of a tumultuous relationship.

Placements are for 30 days and are only available to those without concurrent related criminal charges, and not intoxicated. Placement is in a private room with shared bath in a private residence and is contingent on the client following house rules, including avoiding intoxication and illegal activity, complying with all Orders of the Court, being responsible for their own meals, cooperating with other residents and staff, working on their issues and seeking a permanent stable living situation.

There is no charge for the first night. Payment for the balance of the maximum 30 day stay will be based on the client's ability to contribute toward the cost of housing and counseling services. If you cannot contribute financially for whatever reason, services will still be provided but some alternative form of contribution, such as handyman work, will be expected. Support and advocacy will be provided on site and more intensive personal assistance will be available on a sliding scale basis from a licensed therapist.

There are only two rooms available and if these are filled we can offer counseling, support and advocacy but no further placements until a previously occupied room is vacated. Placement can only be requested between the hours of 7am and 10 pm by calling 672-5750. Our staff is all volunteer and will often be dealing with their private lives so you may be greeted by a voicemail, but we will respond to messages as soon as possible.
